Attention of those arriving on Sunday night:

You may check in at the Porters' Lodge on Storey's Way any time **from 2pm**. Sunday dinner is included in the cost of the course. It is suggested that all residential participants may like to meet informally in the Dining Hall on Sunday night, between 6 and 7pm, and have dinner together.

ON THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL (Friday):

You will be asked to **check out by 9:30 am** but will be able to leave your luggage safely near the Porters' Lodge.

Lessons will finish at 3:30 pm, and, after a few goodbyes, you will be free to go home!

PARKING:

Free parking is available on the **first come – first served** basis, both in the Storey's Way and the Huntingdon Road car park. There is also free parking along the road on Storey's Way.

ON YOUR ARRIVAL:

Please go to Porters' Lodge on Storey's Way. They will give you a key to your room, and a map of the college.

Getting there by public transport on SUNDAY 6th August afternoon/evening:

If you arrive by train, take any bus from the railway station that goes to to the city centre (10 min). There are plenty of buses: Citi 1, Citi 2, Citi 3, Park and Ride PR4, U (Universal). Stops are on the far left, across the road, as you come out of the station.

(If you catch the U bus, it'll take you straight to your destination – get off at the stop "Storey's Way".)

Once in the city centre (E – Emmanuel Street; D – Drummer Street):



- Citi 4 Bay D10 (towards Cambourne) ... 15:10, 16:10, 17:10, 18:10 & no later; get off at the stop "Storey's Way".
- **X3** Bay D3 (towards Huntington) ... 15:00, 16:00, 17:00, 18:30, 19:40 & 20:45; get off at the stop "Storey's Way".
- **Citi 5** Stop E4 (towards Longstanton) ... 15:50, 16:50, 17:50 & no later; get off at the stop "Fitzwilliam College" (on Huntingdon Rd).
- Citi 6 Stop E5 (towards Oakington) ... 15:20, 16:20, 17:20, 18:20

& no later; get off at the stop "Fitzwilliam College" (on Huntingdon Rd).

6-7 min ride.

Taxis: There is a taxi rank at the station.

Local taxi numbers: Panther (01223) 715 715, Cabco (01223) 31 31 31. Uber also exists and works fine.







Or you can walk – it's about 50 min on foot from the railway station (or 25 min from the city centre)!

NB If you have an opportunity and feel the inclination, you may wish to **bring your bike** with you.

It's an 8 minutes ride to the city centre (cycling back to Fitzwilliam College would be somewhat uphill).
